SAY IT:

Obedience is trusting those who lead you by doing what you're asked to do.

KNOW IT:

Ask a kid:

- Who are three adults you trust to guide and protect you?
- What are some rules that keep you safe?

Ask a grown up:

- Who do you trust to lead you now?
- Have you ever disobeyed someone because you thought your way was better? What would you do differently next time?

SEE IT:

On YouTube, look up the scene in *Finding Nemo* where Nemo swims out to the boat, despite his father's warning. Why did his father not want him to swim out to the boat? What did his father know that Nemo didn't? What would have happened if Nemo had obeyed his father?

BE IT:

As a family, practice obedience by play "Simon Says." Take turns being "Simon" and being the ones to obey whatever Simon says!
