SAY IT:

Respect is showing others they are important by what you say and do.

KNOW IT:

Ask a kid:

- Who do you know that gets disrespected often?
- When is it hard to show respect?
- How do you show respect with words?

Ask a grown up:

- What are some excuses you have used (or seen others use) for not giving people respect?
- What is one way your family can show respect to one another?

SEE IT:

Go to YouTube to watch Kid President's video "20 Things We Should Say More Often." What advice does Kid President offer us about being respectful to others? How can we show others they are important by what we say and do?

BE IT:

In honor of Valentine's Day, make some cards to give to those who give to us. Show some respect to fire fighters, police officers, hospital staff members, your hair dresser, a waitress at your favorite restaurant, anyone! Make a handful of cards and keep them in your car to hand out all month.
